I. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Gonzalo Huerta welcomed all in attendance.

II. IDENTIFICATION OF COMPLETED STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES

Kathy Berry addressed the issue of identifying SLO's for each course. She stated the following:

- Student Learning outcomes are an accreditation requirement.
- Imperial Valley College is on a warning status.
- Imperial Valley College was given two years to improve deficiencies.
- She had spoken to Suzanne Gretz regarding student learning outcomes.
- Student learning outcomes would not be tied to faculty evaluations.
- Student learning outcomes can be simple.
- Student learning outcomes can be written oba and office hours.
- Student learning outcomes do not have to be written outside normal hours.
- Offered to help with student learning outcomes.

After Kathy Berry left Gonzalo Huerta brought to our attention the memo he had written on September 8, 2008.
