Etudes Login Information

What is Etudes-NG?

We have chosen Etudes-NG as our Course Management System (CMS). Etudes-NG is designed to provide faculty and students with a powerful, web-based collaboration and learning environment.

Login to Your Etudes-NG Course

To login to your course, you will need to do the following:

1. Go to the Etudes website at: <http://etudes-ng.fhda.edu/portal>
2. For user id, enter **the first two letters of your first name, the first two letters of your last name, and the last five digits of your "G" number**. For example, Pedro Rosas's "G" number is G00123456, so his login username would be pero23456.
3. The default password is: **mmdd (month and day) for your birthday**. For example, Pedro's birthday is April 21, so his password would be 0421.
4. Once logged in, to change your password, go to **My Workspace > Account > Modify Details**. Then type in your password in both the **"Create Password"** and **"Verify Password"** text boxes. Update Email address if needed and click **"Update Details."**

General Advice for Online Students

- ⇒ Most courses require one or more books—be sure you buy them as soon as possible. Books can be purchased at the IVC Bookstore or online by clicking on the bookstore link located on the IVC website.
- ⇒ Print out your syllabus and other important documents, such as assignments.
- ⇒ Schedule time to work on your course (6 - 10 hours a week per class).
- ⇒ Maintain regular contact with your instructor and read and answer email every other day, at a minimum.
- ⇒ Be aware of your instructor's deadlines and policies.
- ⇒ If you are not clear about how your course works, contact your instructor.
- ⇒ Attend the mandatory scheduled orientation for your online class.
- ⇒ Bookmark or add to your Internet "Favorites" the Etudes login portal. Don't rely on going through the IVC website as at times the website is down.
