This afternoon, the CTA Executive Committee met to tabulate the votes which had been accepted by the close of business today (5:00 p.m.). The District's offer proposed a one percent (1%) on salary schedule and one percent (1%) off salary schedule retroactive for the 2000-2001 academic year (plus other items). There were forty-four (44) votes received; thirty (30) votes approving the District's offer and fourteen (14) votes against.

I am writing to inform you that the CTA membership has accepted the District's offer. I am also writing to express our thanks that the Trustees have agreed to hold a special meeting in order to ratify the agreement prior to the end of the fiscal year.

Resolution No. 12217: **AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE DISTRICT AND CTA FOR THE 2000-2001 SCHOOL YEAR**

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board ratifies the Agreement between the District and CTA for the 2000-2001 school year, as follows:

1. Salary Increase for fiscal year 2000-2001:

1% on salary schedule (contract wages only) and 1% off salary schedule (contract wages only) retroactive to August 14, 2000, for teaching faculty and July 1, 2000 for non-teaching faculty; and
2. Two (2) year calendar (2002-2003, 2003-2004) (attached).
3. Extend three (3) hours lecture release time for CTA President through spring 2001.
4. CTA and the District agree to establish a workload policy for distance learning classes.
