1. Resolution No. 14824: Budget

BE IT RESOLVED that the Budget for the 2010-2011 academic year be adopted and filed with the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office as presented in Exhibit A.

2. Resolution No. 14825: Resolution to Imperial County for cash flow needs

Authorization to request an advance of 2010-2011 Property Tax revenue in the amount of \$4 million from the Imperial County Board of Supervisors.

WHEREAS, the State of California has not adopted a budget for fiscal year 2010-2011; and

WHEREAS, the State of California does not make its monthly apportionment payments to community colleges when there is no budget in place; and

WHEREAS, in June 2010 the District issued \$6.5 million in TRANs (Tax Revenue Anticipation Notes) to satisfy cash flow needs of the District through the middle of October 2010; and

WHEREAS, it now appears that the State of California may not have a budget until after the November 2, 2010 election; and

WHEREAS, the District will not be able to meet its cash obligations after the middle of October if a state budget is not passed by that time; and

WHEREAS, Education Code Section 85220 allows community colleges to receive advance payment of property taxes from the County Treasury in an amount not to exceed 85% of the amount of taxes which will accrue to the district during the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the District's total anticipated 2010-2011 Property Tax apportionment is \$5.3 million.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Board of the Imperial Community College District hereby authorizes a request to the County of Imperial for an advance on property taxes in the amount of \$4 million.
