AP 6400 Audits

Education Code Section 84040(b), 81644

- 1. On or before April 1 of the fiscal year, the Board of Trustees shall approve the selection of an auditor who shall be a certified public accountant licensed by the California State Board of Accountancy.
 - a. An auditing firm's contract shall be for no more than three years.
 - b. The audit shall include all funds under the control or jurisdiction of the District.
 - c. The audit shall identify all expenditures by source of funds and shall contain:
 - i. A statement that the audit was conducted pursuant to standards and procedures developed in accordance with Education Code Section 84040.5, and
 - ii. A summary of audit exceptions and management recommendations.
- 2. Audit reports for the preceding fiscal year must be presented to the Board and submitted to the state Chancellor's Office by December 31.
