President Mendenhall attended the Academic Senate meeting. An instructor voiced concerned of ethics with the installation of the KBox system on all campus computers. Mr. Lopez explained that the KBox system is able to monitor and determine what sites are visited. He suggested being very careful when using the college's computers. He stated that the college's e-mail server caught a virus that totally wiped the server. The e-mail went off late last Monday (March 30th) and was semi-finalized this morning.

Student Learning Outcomes (SLO) Mr. Lopez clarified that the college developed what is called the Student Learning Outcomes (SLO) as a measure to process and rate students' learning process. The college is currently in Accreditation and we need to demonstrate how are we educating our students. Mr. Lopez will also be developing SLO's for the ASG.
