President Sciaky stated that the Kiwanis Club in conjunction

with all the Imperial Valley Service Clubs will be having a BBO on Sunday, May 16, 2010 to raise funds for the Earthquake victims. The ASG were asked to contribute by donating soft drinks. However, President Sciaky and Mr. Lopez met and felt that by selling can drinks at \$0.50 during the BBO would be more of a benefit. President Sciaky stated that there will be two locations which IVC is one of them and Wilson Jr. High School in El Centro would be the other. The goal is to sell 10,000 plates. The cost per plate is \$10.

IVC Foundation

President Sciaky was contacted by the IVC Foundation requesting volunteers from the Senate to assist with the IVC Tours this Thursday and Friday. Those interested in volunteering, please see President Sciaky for additional details. Mr. Lopez stated that the ASG should volunteer for such a good cause. The IVC Tours are intended for students K-12.

Parliamentarian

Carlos Espericueta attended the College Council meeting last Monday, April 26th. Dr. Gould discussed the Dream Act and how it will impact immigrant students. The Dream Act consists of qualifying undocumented youth who may be eligible for a 6 year long conditional path to citizenship that requires completion of a college degree or two years of military service. Dr. Gould also discussed honoring the World War II Asian Ancestors.

Carlos stated that the Book Rental program was also discussed during the meeting. According to Carlos the students will be required to have a credit card in order to rent a textbook(s) which Carlos felt it was not a very good idea. Mr. Lopez asked how many Senators had a credit card which none of the Senators raised their hand. Mr. Lopez stated that he understands the need of a credit card in order to recoup the money if the textbooks aren't turned in but most students do not have a credit card and he feels that the students aren't prepare to have one especially when most students are right out of high school and do not have a job. Mr. Lopez stated that the ASG wanted to be part of the negotiations of the Book Rental Program but weren't invited. President Sciaky stated that he discussed the credit card issue

with both Dr. Gould and Board of Trustee, Mr. Jerry Hart. Both

Dr. Gould and Mr. Hart agreed with President Sciaky that credit cards aren't a good idea since most students will be in debt before graduating. One possibility discussed was that the college will pay for the textbooks and if such aren't turned in; the fee will be added to the student's record. More information will be available later.
