Storage Container

President Sciaky informed the Senate that he and Mr. Lopez visited the Imperial Valley Recycling Center in El Centro. He stated that the ASG is in need of storage space since the College Center Storage area is now limited with the Pepsi product that is stored there. A new storage container cost \$2,600. A used container costs \$2,100 and according to President Sciaky is not in good condition. Mr. Lopez stated that the ASG needs a new place to store items such as the canopies. According to Mr. Lopez, the ASG had about twenty canopies stored over in the Maintenance Department and every department requests them. There are only six canopies left. The container will be placed over by the Swimming Pool area. The container will be 20ft x 10ft long. Brian Phillips stated that the purchase of a container is a good idea. Mr. Lopez stated that the container will also house a lot of the archive files that are being stored in the Student Affairs Office. This item will be placed in next week's agenda for approval.

Swamp Cooler

President Sciaky and Mr. Lopez discussed the possibility of also purchasing a Swamp Cooler which the cost is at approximately \$2,000. The cooler will be usable when having the Life's a Beach activity or the 4th of July event. According to Mr. Lopez the ASG will receive money from the current Beverage Company, Pepsi-Cola and such will be utilized to make the purchases.
