President Sciaky stated that this year will be very tough with the school budget ad the political actions. He looks forward in working with everyone this year.

President Sciaky stated that there are a number of disgruntled students over the Smoking Policy. A discussion on such item is ongoing at the IVC Student Portal. Mr. Lopez stated that the Tobacco Free policy was a proactive move by the ASG. San Diego beaches have prohibited tobacco. The policy has been a three year endeavor and over 800 participated in the survey. The Student State Senate has passed the same policy; this is a California move. Mr. Lopez stated that smokers are a minority.

President Sciaky has been contacted by several parties such as Invisible Children Foundation requesting the ASG's support. President Sciaky will release more information as it becomes available.

Advisor

Mr. Lopez stated that this year will be very busy. The budget will get a lot worse and there will be very upset individuals. Some will turn to the ASG for assistance. Mr. Lopez's recommendation is not to get involved with personnel matters.

Mr. Lopez stated that due to the budget the Tutoring budget was cut tremendously leaving students without tutors. Mr. Lopez and President Sciaky have discussed the possibility of utilizing about \$10,000 out of the ASG Reserves to assist the Tutoring Center. The item will be placed at the next ASG meeting.
