#7 Contracts: Revenue monies generated from Pepsi Cola and IVC's Chips & Salsa Cafeteria. Pepsi Cola has exclusivity at the campus and gives the ASG a total of \$25,000 in sponsorship. Chips & Salsa pays a \$250 rental agreement every month.

#8 Vending: Revenue from the Pepsi and snack machines.

#10 Membership: Mr. Lopez and the ASG will begin researching on providing discounts on various/multiple department stores and eateries in the Imperial Valley. This will allow the ASG to sell a membership to students that will be useful.

#12 Arcade Revenue: Revenue generated through the billiard tables located in the Casbah (College Center).

#18 Other: Revenue generated from the "for-profit" organizations. Organizations such as financial institutions, jewelry vendors, etc. are charged a \$75 vendor fee.
