Fee for Duplicate Diplomas	Director Carmona handed out a new resolution that is being put forward and would like to share the following with the students:
----------------------------	---

Currently students receive a free copy of their diploma and now due to the budget and what other colleges are doing, IVC would now like to charge \$20.00 per copy of a duplicate diploma for students. Other college's fees range between \$10 to \$30 dollars so IVC decided to go in between and charge \$20.00 per additional copies.

Also, in the past, IVC has given two free copies of IVC transcript and enrollment verifications to students. IVC will be working with an outside vendor (Docufied) to order either

document via web. One benefit of this is that the process will be quicker for the students to obtain their transcripts or enrollment verification. This transition will be to keep IVC in line with other universities to speed up the process for students. The cost for the documents are as followed: \$8.00 for an electronic copy, \$10.00 if mailed out, and a hardcopy delivered within 24 hours will cost \$35.00. According to Ed.Code, the first two document copies are free and the new resolution proposes that instead of first two transcripts free, should be changed enrollment verifications.

Director Carmona stated that this is a service to the students and will eventually help the students when it comes time for them to transfer. Director Carmon also informed the senate that the fee is set by Docufied and not by the college. IVC will still be in the loop to be sure that a student does not have any "holds" in order to receive their documentation. The link for this service will be on the IVC website and the student portal.

The ASG will discuss the item at their planning meeting and this will be going to college council.
