

#### Long Justifications:

1 The gym has inappropriate locking mechanisms on all exterior doors and no secondary door system between the foyer and the gym floor. This makes security difficult and a risk. The infrastructure of the gym, pool, and tennis courts has deteriorated and the funding promised from Measure L or J has been spent/committed. Tennis courts need to be resurfaced, locker rooms must be recondition/remodeled from under-the-ground to the roof due to the plumbing issues. The gym bleechers are the originals and are in need of repair. The scoring and sound mechanisms need help. ETC

- 1 The skills lab #2 in 2100 building is used by RN, VN, MA, EMT, EMTP, and CNA programs. This lab has not been updated since the 2100 building was constructed and used clinical headwalls (medical gasses and electricity) were used at that time. Medical gasses and electricity would have to be rerouted and wallpaper and headwalls replaced and IT wiring updated if necessary
- 2 The Auditorium in the 2100 building is used by multiple programs/departments. The auditorium is in need of an update. The security of the room is jeopardized due to the aging locks on hallway and exit doors. The electric screen is malfunctioning and must be replaced in the near future. The wiring for today's technology must be considered. A face lift in general is needed, due to the wallpaper simple paint and patch is not possible.
