







IV. **ANALYSIS** (evaluate the strengths, challenges, opportunities and needs of your program/department provide thorough interpretation of data and complexity of analysis)

The Campus Safety Department prides itself on being a well-trained non-sworn safety department in the California Community College District. All of the Campus Safety Officers (CSOs) in the department have passed or are in the process of completing the Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Reserve Officer Level III and II academies. In addition to their law enforcement training, all new hire CSOs are required to take online courses in Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training, Understanding and Planning for School Bomb Incidents, Psychological First Aid, Victim Assistance Training and a 24-hour Campus Safety Officer course that is compliant with SB 1626 and California Education Code 38001.5/72330.5.

Through other grant funded trainings, CSOs have traveled to New Mexico to attend week long courses in Incident Response to Terrorist Bombings, Prevention of and Response to Suicide Bombing Incidents. CSOs have attended courses in Nevada for the Weapons of Mass Destruction Radiological/Nuclear Hazardous Materials Technician course; as well as throughout the State of California for various other courses.

Findings have revealed that due to the growth of the student population at the main campus, crime such as vandalism, theft, and drug use on campus has increased. Based on the annual departmental budget in the future, the department will increase its volunteer staff as well as its paid staff to meet the demands of the growing college population.

Cameras will be placed in multiple areas of the campus as well as additional personnel to be used as a deterrent and witness to crimes/violations that occur on campus.

A push for campus wide trainings for administration, faculty, and staff regarding disaster preparedness and campus evacuations will be introduced through online /face to face meetings. "Building Captains" will be selected and trained to assist with the evacuation of buildings in an organized manner.

A POST certified District Police Department will be created by the District Board to create a service upgrade for the campus that will provide powers of arrest and faster response times for the campus community.
