Benefit: Priority registration status in the highest grouping together with DSP&S, Veterans, and EOPS.

Eligibility: Current or former Foster Youth whose dependency was established or continued by the court on or after the youth's 16th birthday and who is no older than 25 years of age at the commencement of the academic year.

Required one or more of the following documents:

- County Letter
- Letter on official county letterhead from student's county of origin
- County Foster Care Verification Card
- Letter from ILP Coordinator
- Dependency Verification Letter
