Treasurer Moncada attended the Budget Planning Committee meeting last Wednesday, October 31, 2012. FTE's were discussed and emphasized on the importance of the reporting numbers for the college. The committee discussed the different scenarios if Prop 30 was to pass or not to pass. The committee also discussed the possibility of going away with College Hour in the Fall 2013 to free some time for classes.
