President Tylanda welcomed everyone back to another semester.

President Tylanda stated that there will be a Transit Public Hearing tomorrow, Thursday, January 24, 2013 at the IID William R. Condit Auditorium, 1285 Broadway in El Centro, CA at 3:00 p.m.

Dean Lopez stated that there is a real need to increase the express bus routes from/to Calexico/IVC. The lack of transportation has been a true nightmare for students. Approximately 25 students are being left behind every morning from Calexico to IVC. The ASG was also notified that more than two dozen students were left behind last night at IVC due to the lack of space on the express bus. Therefore, Dean Lopez emphasized the importance of Senators and students to attend the hearing. Students need to push for additional routes to accommodate students from Calexico and Brawley. Dean Lopez stated that maybe the college can impose a transportation fee in order to add additional routes but that is something it would need to be glanced out.
