Affairs

It was motioned and seconded by the Affairs Commission to approve expenditures in the amount of \$1,800 towards the Spring Awards Banquet in May. Senator Beltran provided a breakdown of expenditures

- **\$849.50** – Frames (total of 50 at \$16.99 each)
- **\$345.54** – Awards & Trophies (Mr./Ms. Freshman & Sophomore)
- **\$436.38** – Centerpieces
- **\$100** – Cakes

Total: \$1,731.42

Senator Beltran stated that the total does not include sales tax.

Therefore, they rounded off the amount to be \$1,800.

The motion carried without further discussion.

Cultural

VP Reyes stated that the Cesar Chavez Celebration is scheduled for this Thursday, March 28, 2013 at 12:00 p.m. in the College Center. Oranges and “saladitos” will be given to the attendees along with a presentation by English Instructor, Mr. Angel Sandoval.

Treasurer Moncada stated that the Women’s History Day Celebration scheduled last Thursday, March 21, 2013 was not well attended as the publicity was done at the last minute. Two guest speakers, out of the three speakers invited, attended the event. Treasurer Moncada stated that the speeches were great. Both guest speakers were awarded with a \$25 gift certificate to Olive Garden appreciating their time.

Other Committees

Finance

The Finance Committee did not present the budget transfers recommended during their March 15, 2013 meeting. The committee will be presenting a formal budget transfer during their April 8th meeting for approval.

The Finance Committee also discussed the Student Honor Society and is recommending moving forward with implementing it. President Tylenda requested some GPA data from Director of Admissions & Records, Ms. Gloria Hoisington and the table is below:

Rules

The Rules Committee met last Monday, March 18, 2013 and the committee reviewed the Royalty Act of 1968 and the recommendation is below:

Currently reads as: *“Royalty may be selected for the traditional Arab Sweetheart Dance held during the year. There may be a “queen” or “sweetheart” and two princesses, except in cases of a tie in the voting. In such cases there may be up to four princesses.”*

→ **Changed to:** *“Royalty may be selected for the traditional Arab Sweetheart Coronation held during the year. There may be a “queen” & “king” and two princesses, and two princes, except in cases of a tie in the voting. In such cases there may be up to four princesses and four princes.”*

It was motioned and seconded by the Rules Committee to approve the first reading of the Royalty Act of 1968 as stated above.

Discussion: *Dean Lopez explained that the second reading will be done at the April 8th meeting. The motion carried without further discussion.*

Parliamentarian Ortega also stated that the Rules Committee will discuss having the President be a voting member. Dean Lopez suggested spelling it out on a resolution and presented to the Senate for the final approval. This item will be discussed further at the next Rules Committee meeting.
