**Affairs**

The 9/11 Commemorative Event took place last, Tuesday, September 11, 2018. Over 2,000 flags were placed by the flag pole near the A&R building as a tribute to the victims and first responders. Secretary Torres thanked everyone for their help. Senator Morales mentioned that there was positive feedback from people in the community as well as members from IVC.

Constitution Day took place this Monday, September 17, 2018 inside the College Center’s foyer area. The first 200 Students received a free Pocket Constitution book. Secretary Torres mentioned how the pocket constitutions were all handed out quickly. Senators Morales expressed how the senators enjoyed giving out the Constitution books to students.

The National Campus Safety Awareness Day is currently taking place. The ASG provided snacks and refreshments to the attendees.

*M/S/C (Morales/Hernandez) approved the expenditures of the Suicide Prevention Awareness event, not to exceed \$200. There was no discussion. Motion passed.*

**Athletics**

Senator Rosas shared that he traveled with the IVC Men’s basketball team on Friday and Saturday to Cerritos College. Senator Rosas works as a Team Manager. Senator Rosas would like to encourage everyone to attend the home games as he believes this team is trying their very best this season.
