### Report to the Committee

### A. Course Offering-P. Pauley

- T. Aguirre passed out Degree Program and Certificate Program worksheet for Ag. Business Management and Ag Science. She stated that in the Degree program you have 4 required courses and lots of electives. In the certificate you have more required and in those required the rotation is not going to come around more frequent.
- P. Pauley would like to have two programs.
  - o Ag Business
  - Crop and Soil Science
- P. Pauley asked why should the certificate program be different than the degree program when the certificate should be core content less GE? T. Aguirre stated that it doesn't have to be different. It can be different and a certificate should be what gives you the ability to get a job without a degree.
- T. Aguirre would like to streamline courses so students can get straight into Cal Poly or equivalent school. She would like to know what classes to merge or eliminate.
- P. Pauley will survey different schools and compare them to IVC and will have it done by March 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Currently offering two short term classes (Burch/Pauley). D. Gilison is concerned about student success rate.
- D. Gilison would like to take better advantage of the part-timers. Instead of combining into split time frame he suggests letting the class go the 16 weeks.
- Offer more Ag classes especially the ones that have requirements in multiple majors and you offer those on a more regular basis.
- D. Gilison will be reviewing application submitted by someone interested in teaching Ag.

### B. Leadership Conference – P. Pauley

• Contest will take place in Butte College on March 1<sup>st</sup> with emphasis in public speaking, individual sales presentation, job interview, and team marketing. Charge is \$25 p/student. Students will benefit from getting the exposure. Deadline to register is February 8<sup>th</sup>.
