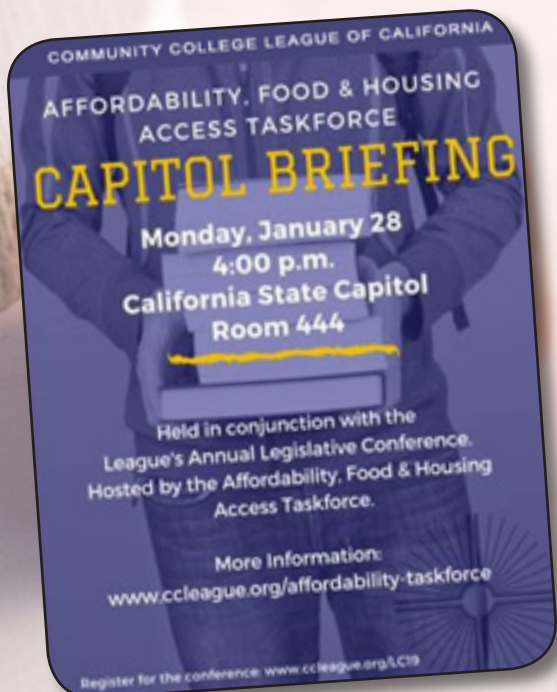

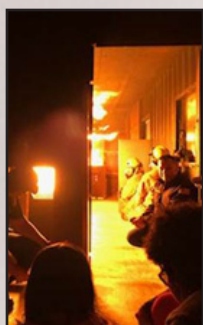

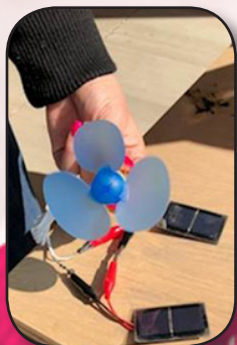
CTE PATHWAYS FOR ADULTS

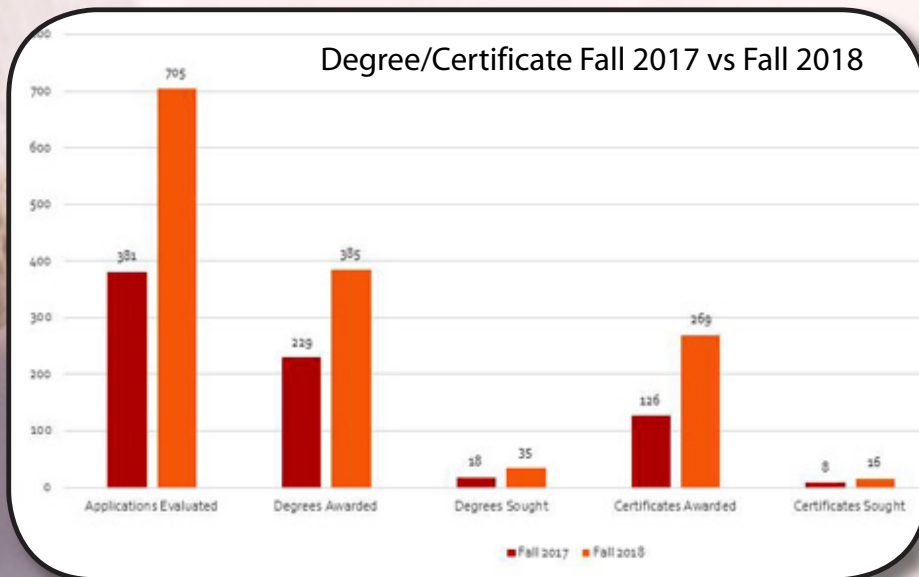
