Board President Sigmond called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Presentation: 6.2 Scorecard Presentation by Director of Institutional Research Jose Carrillo

Director of Institutional Research Jose Carrillo presented a PowerPoint titled, 2016 Student Success Scorecard Overview.

He presented on the 2016 Student Success Scorecard Indicators and reported on four indicators (college profile, momentum points, degree/transfer outcomes and CTE metrics), statewide performance metrics in Remedial Progress, Persistence, Transfer/Completion, and Career Technical Education.

Trustee Salas confirmed that the six year monitoring of the cohort is across the board. Director Carrillo confirmed the information.

Board President Sigmond asked if the progress IVC has over the statewide cohort could be due to the strong support at IVC. Director Carrillo confirmed the information and added that a number of local variables contribute to the success of students.

Trustee Hart asked about the rates for remediation. Director Carrillo provided local remediation rates for first time freshman and explained that for some students six years may not be sufficient to complete a degree given the basic skills sequence they placed in.

Trustee Hart asked how the skill builders are determined. Director Carrillo explained the process of coordinating students that meet the specific criteria, the caveats, and the matching against state earning information. Dean for Economic and Workforce Development Efrain Silva stated that the students in the cohort are from California only and does not include Arizona earnings.

Director Jose Carrillo concluded by introducing, Oliver Zambrano as his new research analyst.
