LOCATION

The Hyatt Regency San Francisco Airport is located at 1333 Bayshore Hwy, Burlingame, CA 94010. The closest airport to the hotel is the San Francisco International Airport. The Hyatt has a limited free shuttle service on demand from the airport. The shuttle is available every day, 24-hours a day and runs every 10-15 minutes. Take your luggage to the Departures Level, center island, and look for the area marked "Hotel Shuttle." The shuttle is a large bus marked "Hyatt Regency and Marriott". Parking and in-room internet is complimenary for SLO Pre-Session attendees.
