### Basic Position Information

Assistant Professor of Nursing in the Health & Public Safety Division. This position is a full-time, tenure track, 177 annual service days which may include teaching day, evening, and weekend classes in theory, clinical and/or simulation lab. Applicant must be qualified to meet Board of Registered Nursing Instructor requirements for Medical/Surgical and one or more nursing content areas specified by the BRN (psychiatric, obstetrics, gerontology, or pediatrics) in an Associate Degree Nursing Program.

### Minimum Qualifications

Must meet one of the following qualifications under (1) (a) through (d) AND (e) AND (2) AND (3):

1.(a) Possess a valid Lifetime California Community College Credential that permits full-time service as an Instructor of Nursing;

-OR-

(b) Possess a Master's degree, from an accredited institution, in nursing;

-OR-

(c) Possess a Bachelor's degree in nursing AND a Master's degree in health education or health science,

-OR-

(d) Possess a combination of education and experience that is at least equivalent to the above.

-AND-

(e) The minimum qualifications as set by the Board of Registered Nursing CCR §1425(c).

• Master's or higher degree from an accredited college or university which includes course work in nursing, education or administration

• Direct patient care experience within the previous five (5) years in the nursing area to which he or she is assigned, which can be met by:

I. One (1) year's continuous, full-time or its equivalent experience providing direct patient care as a registered nurse in the designated nursing area; or

II. One (1) academic year of registered nurse level clinical teaching experience in the designated nursing areas or its equivalent that demonstrates clinical competency; and

III. Completion of at least one (1) years' experience teaching courses related to registered nursing or completion of a post-baccalaureate course which includes practice in teaching registered nursing.

-AND-

2. A valid, active license issued by the California Board of Registered Nursing;

-AND-

3. Demonstrate sensitivity to and ability to work with diverse academic, socio-economic, cultural, and ethnic backgrounds of community college students, including those with disabilities (AB 1725, 87360a).
