Credentials Solutions Online Parking Permits

Parking Control Officer; Ms. Gina Madrid gave a brief presentation pertaining to the transition of ordering parking permits online through Credentials Solutions Company. The company has been operating since 1997 and currently provides their services to 56 California Community Colleges. According to Ms. Madrid she has only heard very positive feedback in regards to Credential Solutions. The Parking Control Office is seeking to raise the parking permits as follow:

❖ Fall/Spring Semesters: Vehicles from \$20 to \$25 for Motorcycles from \$10 to \$15

❖ Summer/Winter Intersession: Vehicles from \$10 to \$15 for Motorcycles from \$7 to \$12

The increase will cover the \$3.10 that Credential Solutions charges for the processing of the parking permits, the postage, etc.

Ms. Madrid read Senate Bill 774, Section 76360 of the Education Code: Section 1 reads as follow:

"The governing board of a community college district may require students in attendance and employees of the district to pay a fee, in an amount, not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50) per semester and twenty-five dollars (\$25) per intersession, to be established by the board, for parking services. The fee shall only be required of students and employees using parking services and shall not exceed the actual cost of providing parking services."

Dean Lopez stated that the parking lots need to be resurfaced every so often and parking fees cover this expense. Dean Lopez suggested Ms. Madrid to tie Credential Solutions with registration. Ms. Madrid hopes to launch Credential Solutions for the Spring 2013 semester.

Ms. Madrid answered questions from the Senators. President Tylenda thanked Ms. Madrid for her presentation.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Senators

Senator Robles is currently researching the possibility of having a Starbucks Coffee Shop on campus. Dean Lopez reminded him that construction and initial cost of labor, and the purchase of the equipment should also be taken into consideration when bringing back the cost breakdown. Dean Lopez reminded the Senate that they only have approximately \$57K in reserves which might not be enough for such a project. However, he encourages that the project be thoroughly researched.

President

President Tylenda would like to have all Senators attend the December 12, 2012 Board of Trustees meeting. She will be discussing this item at their Planning meeting on Wednesday.

The ASG will be assisting the Students for Political Awareness (SPA) Club with their annual Thanksgiving Dinner at Niland/Slab City. The ASG will be purchasing dessert and will assist decorating, and serving dinner.
