**PUBLIC COMMENTS** Dr. Michael Heumann, stated that textbooks for students keep getting

expensive every semester. He is working with a group of faculty members to try to find ways to help students with this problem. California Assembly Bill No. 798 was approved by Governor Brown in October 8, 2015 to establish the College Textbook Affordability Act of 2015. Such act reads "to reduce costs for college students by encouraging faculty to accelerate the adoption of lower cost, high-quality open educational resources, as defined." Dr. Heumann is in the process of developing a plan to get money to help with endeavors. Good small number of faculty that support this plan but not the majority. He is willing to work with ASG to get more faculty involved and to make the students aware of what the plan is. The deadline is June 30, 2016.
