Phi Theta Kappa

At 1:11 p.m., Mr. Eric Lehtonen and Dr. Cynthia Spence gave a brief presentation along with a 1-minute video in support of Phi Theta Kappa Student Society on campus. Mr. Lehtonen and Dr. Spence also presented a power point presentation. They asked for ASG's support and the funding of \$500 to cover the institution's fee. Students must meet a few requirements such as a 3.5 GPA, have at least 12 units completed and cover a \$60 membership fee and have a minimum of ten (10) students to being the chartering process. The institution fee and the student membership fee is a one-time payment as long as the college keeps the continuity of the chartered status. Students who become a member will be recognized nationally, will receive a lapel pin, an I.D. Card and an official press release. Mr. Lehtonen and Dr. Spence are committed to make this student honor society group a reality and will seek assistance from the IVC Foundation and other Faculty Members to sponsor students who are not financially stable to cover the \$60 membership fee.

The benefits from joining the Phi Theta Kappa includes scholarships even when transferring to a 4-year university. An official seal will be place on the college's diploma and a notation of membership will be placed on your college transcripts.

Mr. Lehtonen and Dr. Spence had the opportunity to answer several questions and were excused at 1:43 p.m.
