  - Todd Evangaliste—Currently no faculty members are directing payroll deductions to this scholarship fund.
- 7. Senate Executive Committee's Role in Off-Contract Periods—Michael Heumann—Other campuses authorize their executive committees to act for the Academic Senate. There would have to be Senate approval for this to happen here.

- 8. Ad-Hoc Class Cancellation Committee Membership—Michael Heumann--Three members are Ed Wells, Frank Rapp, and Eric Lehtonen.
- 9. Plenary Resolutions—Michael Heumann—We'll already talked about this and will revisit this again.
