 Approval of the proposed Outcomes and Assessment Committee, effective Fall 2019 (Blek/Soto/no action)

The Senate reviewed the Purpose and Function for the proposed campus-wide committee.

Discussion centered on ensuring a faculty majority on the committee, and specific recommendations were proposed for the number of Academic Senate appointed faculty. Specifically, it was suggested that four (4) faculty be appointed from the Arts, Letters, &

Learning Services Division, four (4) faculty be appointed from the Math & Sciences Division, two (2) faculty appointed from Economic and Workforce Development Division, two (2) faculty appointed from Health and Public Safety Division, two to four (2-4) faculty from Counseling. It was noted the Student Affairs & Enrollment Services area does not have any faculty; this area was moved out of the Senate-appointed faculty section.

Additional discussion followed suggesting that the Academic Senate decide how to divide the Outcomes and Assessment Committee into workgroups rather than leave that work to the committee co-chairs.
