Accreditation reports are prepared by a small number of administrators and faculty.

The writing of the reports is delayed to the last minute and the process is rushed.

Approval of the reports through participatory governance is rushed and the reports are not read by the groups approving the documents.

Six of the 14 sections of the ISER are assigned to specific committees in the participatory governance matrix.

The assigned standards are regularly reviewed by the appropriate committee on a regular basis.

CART reviews and updates the following sections of the ISER on an annual basis:

- Eligibility Requirements
- Commission Policies
- Student Achievement Data
- Institution-set Standards
- Organizational Information

Sections of the Institutional Self Evaluation Report are assigned to multiple groups in the participatory governance matrix (including the governing board).

Standards assigned to committees are reviewed and updated on an annual basis.

Annually, the members of CART review and update the following:

- Introduction
- Student Achievement Data
- Institution-set Standards
- Organizational Information
- Eligibility Requirements
- Commission Policies

CART monitors institutional activities in support of continuous improvement based on the QFE and Changes & Plans arising out of the ISER.

Evidentiary materials are updated annually or archived.

Regular updates are provided to the governing board quarterly. The governing board assesses their effectiveness on previously established board goals.

Students are involved in the integrated planning efforts of the institution. Student schedules are considered in the scheduling of committee meetings.

Board Policies are reviewed and updated on a regular basis, and Administrative Procedures are regularly assessed for appropriateness, compliance, and effectiveness.
