V. ANNOUNCEMENTS

The gowns are worn-out and in the event of expediting an order, it costs couple hundred dollars because the gowns are shipped from the east coast. Our San Diego Sales Representative stated we will benefit from changing the color gown to black. This item will be brought back to the committee in March for further discussion.
- The IVC mascot change was brought up by Student Representative Guzman. The history of the changed was shared with the committee members. ASG surveyed the students regarding a change twice in the last 15 years with the resolutions ending with the Board of Trustees for their final approval and unfortunately both times the change was turned down. ASG President Bermudez stated she would like to discuss this item once more with the ASG Senate.
- Dean Martinez-Inzunza attended an Imperial Valley Transit meeting. The I.V. Transit discussed the possibility of adding additional express routes to Calexico in the evening. The formal recommendations will be presented in March.

- A proposal to change college hour later in the day is being spearheaded by College Council. The ASG is currently working with Mr. Jose Carrillo on developing a student survey in regards to this proposal. More information will be released at the next meeting.
