## C. New Discussion

- a. Summer 2014, Fall 2014, Winter 2015, Spring 2015, Summer 2015 Schedules.
  - ✓ Summer 2014 schedule is complete. Registration for summer begins April 29.
  - Still in the process of doing PT faculty for fall 2014. Once complete will email to everyone. No major changes to schedule. Hoping to have them done by end of week.
  - ✓ 2015 winter, spring and summer schedules are ready he just needs to go through the faculty selection process. Winter and summer will be by seniority and spring will be the normal way.
  - ✓ We may be able to add more classes for Winter/Summer. This will depend on what the budget looks like.

## **b.** Printing Costs

- SME department has gone over budget.
- Printing on copier in conference room costs 10¢ per page/side plus you're paying for the paper.
- When using reprographics you pay 5¢ per page.
- If you submit a reprographics ticket and they print it out on big copier there you pay 4¢ per page.
- Strongly recommends using reprographics. They deliver to SME office. We don't pay for the paper only the printing. We could cut printing budget by 60%.
