C. Action Items

1. Department Chair Election

✓ Science department held election for department chair. Votes were tallied and Daniel Gilison was unanimously re-elected (11-0) as department chair for science department.

D. Communications

1. Student Spring Awards

Chair Gilison reminded faculty that email was previously sent out requesting nominations for overall science department award, and for three specific categories (BIO, CHEM, and PHSC) to be presented at the student spring awards banquet.

- Faculty who nominate student usually presents the award at the banquet on Friday, June 1st at Club LoHoo. If faculty is unable to attend Dean Drury or Chair Gilison can present for them. They'll just need a quick bio of student being nominated.
- ✓ Chair Gilison received three nominations for BIO, three for CHEM and two for PHSC. He is recommending Anthony Meza for overall science department award. CHEM faculty withdrew all other names and only nominated Sara Fink.
- ✓ Chair Gilison will send email with names that were submitted for the other categories and faculty can vote.

2. SLOs

- \checkmark Chair Gilison emailed current SLO checklist.
- Checklist shows which courses are supposed to be assessed for SLOs this semester, which SLOs to be assessed and in addition to that we need to reduce the number of SLOs that we have and try to simplify SLOs across the board.
- If necessary, he would like to turn a department meeting to a working SLO meeting.

3. Chem Club start-up matching funds

- A. Benedicto reported there are currently 6 applicants, possibly more end of month, for the \$1,000 IVC Chem Club Scholarship Award.
- Chem club would like to provide support for new clubs on campus.
- Provide up to \$550.00 to increase quality of student campus life, help inactive clubs and support for new clubs within their first three years.
- Starts fall 2019.
