2018-19 FINANCIAL AID DISBURSEMENT SCHEDULE

If you have been awarded aid and are otherwise eligible, your funds will be disbursed on the dates listed below. Students awarded after the main disbursement dates listed below will be paid as part of a supplemental disbursement which we process approximately twice per month.

**Enrollment Status Freeze Date:** On this date we will record the units enrolled which will determine your eligibility for financial aid awards for the semester. Any classes that are added or dropped after this date will not impact (either increase or decrease) your financial aid for the semester. If you are enrolled in a late starting course you MUST add it OR be on the Waitlist in WebStar by the freeze date to be counted toward your units enrolled for financial aid purposes. If your FAFSA data is received after the freeze date, your freeze date will be determined at that time. Enrollment status will be adjusted down for courses you drop before the freeze date or that you never attend and any funds paid for those courses will need to be repaid.

**Return to Title IV >60% Drop Date:** If you completely withdraw from all your courses before this date, federal regulations require a recalculation of eligibility which may require that you repay funds. If you fail to successfully complete any classes (receive all F's, W's or NP's), you may be considered an unofficial withdrawal if there is no evidence of academically related activity after this date. This will require a recalculation of eligibility and may require that you repay funds.
