- On May 30th, IVC conducted an emergency active Assailant drill, approximately 100 personnel from various law enforcement and first responder agencies throughout the Valley participated.
- The drill was part of the college's effort to prepare and protect students, staff, and faculty in the event of an emergency involving an armed assailant.
- The drill officially began at 9 a.m. and the entire campus went into a lockdown for 15 minutes. A press conference was held at 10:00 a.m.
- Law enforcement and fire agencies continued their exercise scenarios inside the 3200 building until 1:00 p.m.
- A campus debriefing took place at 2:40 p.m.

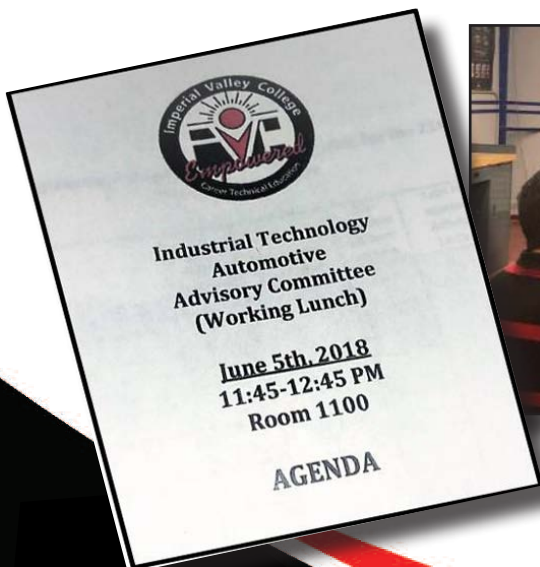
Strategic Enrollment Management (SEM) Academy

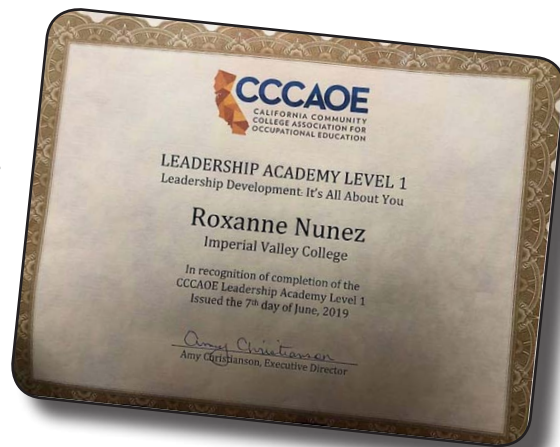
- Child Development students celebrated completion of the program on June 6, 2019.


