What is the Imperial Valley College Educational Talent Search Program?

Imperial Valley College Educational Talent Search is a federally funded program designed to help low-income and potential first-generation college students gain entry to and graduate from an institution of higher education. The goal of the program is to provide assistance to these students as a means to facilitate their post-secondary institutional educational objectives.

Who Provides the Services?

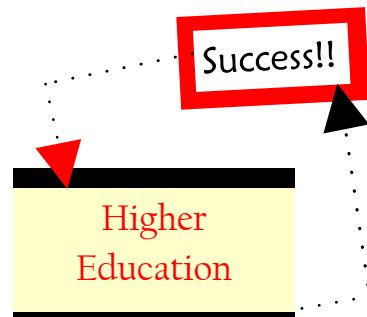
The Educational Talent Search staff provides many services aimed at preparing participants for college and assisting participants with college related materials. The staff, whose commitment is to help students develop the skills necessary to succeed in school, consists of a Program Director, Program Counselors, Lead Tutors, and Peer Tutors.



What does Educational Talent Search Program Offer?

Educational Talent Search Program staff is available to students until graduation from high school and in the transition process to college. Educational Talent Search Program implements an extensive curriculum of supportive services to meet each student's individual academic needs. Some of the services provided include, but are not limited to:

- o Academic and Career Counseling
- o Career / College Prep Workshops
- o Financial Aid Assistance
- o College Admission Process Assistance
- o Tutorial Assistance
- o Parental involvement
- o Fieldtrips to Universities
- o Assistance to Re-enter High School or College.

Who is Eligible?

Students in the designated school sites above are eligible, including students who have dropped out of school, whether high school or college.

If you are a college dropout, we can help you enroll at Imperial Valley College. We can assist you with admission, class registration, FAFSA, BOG, assessment tests, and refer you to a campus program.

To be eligible, a student must:

- *Meet federal eligibility guidelines
- *Have academic potential for admission to post-secondary institution
- *Need program services
- *Complete the E.T.S. application to include parent's recent income verification, copy of student's social security card, and parent educational level.
