### **3. PUBLIC COMMENT**

### Information: 3.1 Instructions to the Public

Dean of Economic and Workforce Development Efrain Silva spoke and informed the Board about two activities planned for the summer, Kids on Campus and the first Business Conference titled, **Unleash Your Business Potential**.

Javier Guitierrez, Computer Technician, and registered voter, presented a PowerPoint titled, *Technical Services*. He presented data related to IVC's IT Help Desk. He asked the Board to repeal the decision to layoff four computer technicians.

Martha Olea, Microcomputer Technician, spoke regarding the IT needs and asked the Board to reconsider their vote.

Steve Cook, Computer Technician for the last 15 years, stated there seemed to be no IT plan. He asked the Board to vote no on the last computer technician and asked the Board rescind the layoffs of the four computer technicians until they have more information.

Laura Hartsock, Administrative Secretary to the nursing program, spoke about her 30 years at IVC and what it has meant to her. She stated CSEA has been told to reduce by \$1.4 million. She stated service oriented people helped her find the way and classified staff fill in the gaps.

Marco Mayelo, father of an IVC student, stated his son could not get classes.

Lisa Solomon, CTA Vice President, serving as chair for Political Action Committee spoke on item 6.2, and stated 300 staff signatures have been received. She spoke regarding the changes from the Student Success TaskForce and stated it was the position of CTA to monitor the legislation with the recommendations and will continue to do that in the upcoming months. She stated it was a pleasure serving as Vice President and announced Krista Byrd would be taking over as CTA Vice President on June 1, 2012.

Gaylla Finnell, CTA President, announced Eric Jacobson would take over as CTA President on June 1, 2012. She shared her experiences and observations and shared her personal experience from the past two years. She spoke regarding the reductions to faculty and stated the responsibility is to the students. She stated it was a pleasure working with the Board and supports them as they make IVC solvent.

Frances Beope, Counselor, spoke and stated that Gaylla Finnell has made a difference. She recommended to the Board moving all extended campuses to main campus as a savings measure. She spoke on a six year budget analysis and reported the changes that have taken place since 2006-2007, and noted the differences in salary schedules.

Alicia Ortega, Professor Emerita, spoke regarding board member travel expenses and asked if there is a board member travel budget and requested an expense report.

#### **5. INFORMATION REPORTS**

#### Presentation: 5.1 Employee of the Month for April by Vice President John Lau

VP Lau introduced Maria Valenzuela as the employee of the month for April 2012. She was unable to be at the meeting.

#### Discussion: 5.2 ARCC Self Assessment by Director Dawn Chun

Director Dawn Chun presented a PowerPoint titled, *Accountability Reporting for Community Colleges*. She reviewed the report and stated this is the IVC yearly report card.

#### Report: 5.3 Board Member Reports Trustee Hart reported the following:

- Attended the CCLC Conference in San Diego and stated six of the seven trustees attended. He reported the information was mainly on the budget and he attended an accreditation session.
- Attended the SDICCCA meeting which included a presentation by UCSD who in recent past, has done away with the TAG agreements which were benefitting the SDICCCA colleges. He said the group also discussed the California budget. He noted if the Governors Tax proposal does not pass, it will mean we lose 400 FTE students.
- Announced he was proud of the successes at the college and enjoys attending the events.
- Announced the retirees will be missed.

Trustee Galindo asked about the information on Accreditation.

Trustee Hart stated that over the last five or six years there has been some kind of sanction at other colleges and stated 71% of the accreditation reports had comments related to leadership and the Board.

#### Trustee Medina reported the following:

 Attended the CCLC Conference in San Diego held May 4-6. He stated discussion sessions he attended were on Accreditation, the Board's Role in Student Success, and Fair Political Practices. He commented the doom and gloom discussions related to budgets and stated the main point was that the ballot measure needs to pass.

#### Trustee Taylor reported the following:

 Attended the CCLC Conference in San Diego held May 4-6, and stated that he hoped there would be closer trainings to the college.

### **Board President Cardenas reported the following:**

 Attended the CCLC Conference in San Diego held May 4-6. He commented that the increase in sales tax is a hard sell, the 400 FTEs in student loss would occur if the measure does not pass, and stated he learned a lot about accreditation and being together as a board.

## Trustee Galindo reported the following:

- Asked what the dollar amount is of the 18% of technical outsourcing from the pie chart that Javier Gutierrez provided in his presentation. She asked why the function is outsourced, asked if the college had the technical expertise, and what the projected amount for next year is.
- Announced she voted in favor of hiring FCMAT at the last meeting; however, stated she is extremely uncomfortable with that decision, given the amount of money which translates into the one groundskeeper position and was not aware that FCMAT had been to the college already to do another study. She stated she has an issue with work reduction and asked the trustees if there was a way to rescind the FCMAT resolution as she feels the expertise to do what is needed is already at the college. She urged the trustees to do something instead of taking another \$50,000. She apologized to her constituents for her FCMAT vote.
- <sup>•</sup> Attended graduation and was distraught to see the number of graduates reduced from last year.
- Attended the Westmorland Redevelopment Agency. She stated with less than a 24 hour notice for Calexico and Holtville she was unable to attend those meetings. She stated the agencies are at the preliminary stage of taking the oath of office and filling out forms. She stated that there would be two subsequent meetings between now and the fall and stated the plan is to have county-wide board by 2016.
- She asked about the new copy service at the college and asked how accounts would be charged. VP Todd Finnell explained there is a cost for printing and how it is being allocated.
- She asked about the FCMAT comments and VP Finnell explained that the study was a limited scope and stated that the document is on the FCMAT website.

President Jaime formally introduced her as the new ASG President.
